LBMS EXTRA-CURRICULAR OFFERINGS

Jazz Ensemble

In Jazz Ensemble, students have the opportunity to explore one of the only styles of music that is uniquely American. The ensemble rehearses as a traditional "Big Band," but is open to students who play nontraditional jazz instruments as well. Students study a mix of well-known charts, improvisation, jazz technique, and tunes arranged for Big Bands.

The ensemble rehearses after school on Tuesdays from 2:15-3:00. It is open to any student who plays an instrument at 6th grade proficiency.

Chorus

In Chorus, students have the opportunity to learn how to sing in a healthy manner, and join in the making of music with their peers. Repertoire spans a wide variety, including jazz, folk, classical, and even pop!

Chorus at LBMS is a unique ensemble as it is encouraged for any student who has never been part of an ensemble before (or even never sung before!) as well as seasoned vocalists. The "come one, come all" attitude allows us to

create a safe space to join together and create something greater than ourselves. The ensemble rehearses after school on Wednesdays from 2:15-3:00. Our first rehearsal will be September 13, 2017

To join either ensemble, attend the first rehearsal and take home permission paperwork for participation.

Drama Club

The LBMS Drama Club provides an opportunity for LBMS students to be a part of a musical production in the spring. No previous drama experience is necessary. There are opportunities for onstage roles or helping with backstage crew or lights and sounds. A meeting for parents and students will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2017, in the Mary Rowlandson auditorium, beginning promptly at 6:30 pm. All interested students should have representation at the meeting of a parent or guardian. Auditions will be on Tuesday, November 14, and Thursday, November 16, 2017, between 6:00 and 8:00 p.m. Rehearsals will begin on Tuesday, November 28, and will run every Tuesday and Thursday through the performances on Friday, March 9, and Saturday, March 10, 2018. Student Council

Student Council will be meeting every other Tuesday beginning on September 19th. Meetings are immediately after school until 3:15. Students will read speeches to their respective class on September 15th during specials. Immediately following student read speeches, elections will occur with five representatives from each grade being named to student council.

Yearbook

The Luther Burbank Middle School Yearbook Club, directed by Mrs. Brennan and Mrs. Parson, is charged with the task of creating a yearbook to be completed and distributed by the last day of the school. Club members will photograph school activities and events, format images, design pages, and assist with the cover contest and the coordination of communications between the yearbook club and students and teachers for submitting information for the yearbook. Meetings will be held Thursdays from 2:15 - 3:00 in the computer lab. The first meeting will be held Thursday, September 21st. A signed permission slip is required before attending a meeting and students can pick up a copy of the permission slip in the library.

Best Buddies

Our Best Buddies chapter assists in facilitating mutually rewarding friendships between students with special needs and their middle school peers, by holding monthly activities after school. We plan to meet on the last Wednesday of each month, beginning September 27th, with a few exceptions (a couple of months we will meet on a different Wednesday). The activities are held from 2:15-3:10 in Mrs. Lonardo's classroom. Sign-ups have started on-line at www.bestbuddiesonline.org, or a paper copy may be picked up at the school. Students may not participate in Best Buddies until a signed application has been received.

Art Club

Art club is open to anyone in grades 6, 7, and 8. Art club is an opportunity to work with a variety of art materials and to explore and be creative. A specific project will be completed each week. Sample art projects include: Chinese brush painting, watercolor compositions, charcoal drawings, and collage. The last week of each month students may choose the art medium they wish to work with. Students must turn in a completed art club permission slip in order to attend the first meeting. Mrs. Slattery will have these available during class and will leave extra forms in a pocket folder on her door. Art club will start on Monday, September 18.

Intramurals

The LBMS intramural program is open to all students in grades 6-8. It is a supervised after school athletic activity that promotes fair play and physical fitness, free of charge to LBMS students. Our Intramural Program is currently underway with Flag Football on Tuesdays and Thursdays after school, 2:15-4:00.

A morning program will be piloted on Tuesday mornings, 7:00-7:30. Starting next week on September 19th, "Mindful Mornings" will be offered. This is a great way to start the day with light exercise and "Yoga" style stretching. Research shows that by exercising in the morning the mind and body are better prepared to focus on the day ahead! Now in its second year, the Burbank Green Team will continue with their recycling initiative, daily morning announcement Green Tips, and special Earth Day Advisory activities. The team hopes to start some new projects this year so students are asked to bring their eco-friendly ideas and work together to make a change! Green Team will meet on Thursdays after school from 2:15-3:05pm. Due to staff meetings that take place the first Thursday of each month, the team will, instead, meet in collaboration with the Art Club on Mondays during staff meeting weeks. The first meeting will take place this Thursday, Sept. 14th.
